A new home for the Fire Brigade: The fire station is a robust brick building designed as a villa integrated in the green surroundings. It combines sustainability, functionality and an attractive 24/7 operational working and living environment. The spatial development with various vistas makes the organization clear and transparent, allowing visitors a glimpse of the dynamic environment of the fire station. A striking feature of the interior is the majestic staircase that connects all floors and functions and offers views to the different layers and spaces of the building. From the locker room on the first floor the fire trucks on the ground floor can be seen. On the upper floor roof gardens, patio's and terraces provide the building of its specific sculptural expression, creating outdoor spaces for different users with each their own specific identity.
